This revision of MasterKey4 is for use with Revit 2026

Release Notes and Updates on 20.08.2026

This update to MasterKey4 is for use with Revit 2026, following Autodesk's release of the Revit 2026.5 update, which upgrades Revit's underlying framework from Microsoft's .NET 8 to .NET 10. MasterKey4 has been rebuilt to run under .NET 10 and also includes a fix for an issue that could cause failures during the sequencing of a sync to central or cloud-based model.

Key improvements include:

Compatibility with Revit 2026.5 (.NET 10):

MasterKey4 has been recompiled to run on Microsoft's .NET 10 framework, matching the runtime now used by Revit 2026.5 and later releases in the 2026 product line.

Fix for Sync to Central / Cloud Model Failures:

We have resolved possible issues that could cause MasterKey4 to fail during the a sync to central or cloud models, improving reliability when working in shared, multi-user projects.

Important – Please Read Before Installing:

Only install this MasterKey4 update if you have also installed the Revit 2026.5 (.NET 10) update or later releases. If you have not yet updated Revit to 2026.5, please remain on your current build of MasterKey4, as this new build requires the .NET 10 runtime and will not run correctly on earlier .NET 8 installs of Revit 2026.

Revit 2025 Users:

Autodesk's .NET 10 update for Revit 2025 (Revit 2025.5) is currently in preview and is expected to be released around mid-September 2026. A matching .NET 10 build of MasterKey4 for Revit 2025 will follow. Until then, please continue using your current build of MasterKey4 with Revit 2025.

Revit 2024 Users:

Revit 2024 is not part of Autodesk's .NET 10 migration and will remain on .NET 8. No update to MasterKey4 is required for Revit 2024 at this time.

Revit 2027 Users:

Revit 2027 was released with .NET 10 from launch, so MasterKey4 for Revit 2027 is unaffected by this change and no update is required.
