



MasterKey 2.0 Updated Build No. 2018.6.21.98

This revision of MasterKey2 is for Revit 2017,2018 and a new release for Revit 2019

Updates and Fixes made in this Release to MasterKey2 for Revit 25.06.2018

Updates

1. Additional Audit functionality: MasterKey can now 'audit' the keynotes of an entire project to identify all current instances of keynotes that have not been assigned by MasterKey. The new functionality also enables MasterKey users to assign single and multiple keynotes through the same process window.
2. Warning Note added: If a Revit user is in edit mode and simultaneously attempts to refresh or audit the MasterKey palette, the user is then prompted to escape edit mode to complete the MasterKey refresh or audit function. The process cannot be completed while Revit is in edit mode, as writing back to the keynote table is blocked until the edit process is completed.

Fixes

1. Issues with graphic resolution and resizing inside the MasterKey palette with Revit 2018.3 onwards have been fixed for the MasterKey palette.
2. MasterKey Keynote numbers are now locked to CAPS so suffixes are consistent in format regardless of the text format set by the practice administrator.
3. Keynote text and number alignment in the palette is now top left justified, to help with legibility for users when longer keynote descriptions are being used.

NB. Please ensure all users within your organisation have the same build number when working on a workshare project.
